## Barton Marine 'I' Section Track

For Mainsheet travellers and self tacking jibs

Barton Marine has enjoyed a long association with Canadian Mike Water's W17 trimaran class.

Primarily for home built completion, this versatile design offers extended cruising possibilities with added stability.

The example we have here is owned and built by Andrew Johnson of Malvest Marine in the Philippines. He is an avid sailor having already completed over 1200 miles in his W17 around the Philippine islands.

Barton helped with the specification of the W17 supplying the 24mm (15/16") 'l' section Barton mainsheet track (the design of which allows for some extreme track curving, allowing perfect set of the high aspect mainsail). The system also features a 2:1 purchase and cleating system which is easily reached from the helm position. We can also supply jib and spinnaker blocks, cleats and jib furlers.
